



Natural Diapering Spray

a hydrosol blend for fabric baby wipes

Ingredients

- 2 ounces Witch Hazel Hydrosol
- 1 ounce Yarrow Hydrosol
- 1 ounce Lavender Hydrosol

This recipe makes about four ounces

Directions:

1. Mix the Hydrosols together in a spray bottle. Shake well.

Usage & Packaging:

This spray is best packaged in a Glass or Aluminum Sprayer Bottle. Keep a spray bottle handy on your changing table or in your diaper bag. This recipe can be doubled or tripled, but a larger amount should be kept in the refrigerator for long-term storage.

To use, spritz your homemade wipes lightly with the spray. Use the moistened wipes to gently cleanse your baby's bottom. Follow with a light coating of natural baby oil or natural baby balm.
