



Grapefruit Eucalyptus Soap Bars

made with kaolin clay

Ingredients

- 1 pound Clear Coconut Melt & Pour Base
- 2 tablespoons White Kaolin Clay
- 1 tablespoon Aloe Vera Gel (or water)
- 2 teaspoons Avocado Oil
- 1/2 teaspoon Gemtone Garnet Mica
- 1/2 teaspoon Gemtone Emerald Mica
- 1 - 2 teaspoons Enchanted Eucalyptus Plant-Based Fragrance Oil
- 1 - 2 teaspoons Grapefruit Splash Plant-Based Fragrance Oil
- a small sprayer bottle filled with rubbing alcohol

This recipe makes one pound of soap

Directions:

1. Cut the Melt & Pour Base into cubes, then melt it in a double boiler.
2. Mix the Kaolin Clay and Aloe Vera Gel together in a small bowl, then mix that paste into the soap base.
3. In two other bowls, mix each of the micas with 1 teaspoon of Avocado Oil, forming a slurry in each bowl.
4. Remove the soap base from the heat, and divide it in half. Add the Gemtone Emerald Mica and Enchanted Eucalyptus Plant-Based Fragrance Oil to the first half, mixing well to thoroughly combine the ingredients. Return the second half of the base to the heat so that it remains melted.
5. Carefully pour the colored and scented soap into your soap molds, filling each mold about half-way up. Allow the soap to cool and harden until the top layer of the soap sets.
6. Once the first half of the soap sets just enough to support the second layer, start working on your second half of the soap. Remove it from the heat, and mix in the Gemtone Garnet Mica and the Grapefruit Splash Plant-Based Fragrance Oil. Mix the ingredients well to combine.
7. Spritz each soap in the mold with rubbing alcohol, then carefully pour the second layer of soap into the molds. Allow the bars to cool and harden completely before removing them from the mold.



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Usage & Packaging:

Melt and Pour soaps should be wiped down with a clean paper towel and then wrapped tightly in plastic wrap or packaged in air tight cello bags.
